Stakeholder Meeting Notes –

- Reviewed schedule and overview
- Reviewed hours/timing per night
- Southgate – will be staffed at the pool entry point to protect
- Azie Morton will not be closed
- NO additional traffic control added in/around Sterzing/Toomey
- Ride share and scooters reviewed.
 - Allowing devices into the event up unto the Pecan Grove parking lot area
- Add/check no event parking sign at Barton Hills Drive at Lamar and Barton Skyway
 - Deerfoot Trail and Barton Hills Drive – no parking messaging sign has been missing the last couple of events – cross over and becomes Cliffside Drive
- Trash along Azie Morton – add some extra barrels along the corridor to help out.
- Trash barrels at Barton Hills market. 1 at corner of Barton Hills and one closer to Barton Hills and Azie.
- More trash cans at Sunset and along Barton Springs Road. Along the Sunset area.
- Reviewed request to move toward a standard closure time the entire run for consistency.
 - Previously some lane closure nights (approximately 4 nights), then full closure around 5 pm the duration of the event.
 - Asking to consider closing Barton Springs finishing at/after 5:30 pm with eastbound (inbound) neighborhood traffic last.
 - There is desire to achieve consistency for expectation and messaging purposes.
