

## **ZNA General Meeting Minutes for Feb 28, 2022**

### **Zilker Elementary School cafeteria, 1900 Bluebonnet Ave.**

Meeting called to order by President Bill Bunch at 7:00 pm.

Greetings and quick introduction of those attending.

Announcement that the Zilker Neighborhood area east of Kinney Avenue is now part of City Council District 9, whose councilmember is Kathy Tovo. The rest of the neighborhood remains in District 5, which is served by Ann Kitchen.

Announcement that two construction cranes will be raised at the Brodie Oaks Shopping Center on March 4 in order to show the heights of buildings in the proposed redevelopment project. The cranes will hoist flags 160' and 275' high.

Parks & Environment Report. Discussion of upcoming Zilker Park Vision Plan and the three options in the latest public survey. Also discussed were aspects of the options such as "rewilding", parking, traffic, and a possible land bridge over Barton Springs Road.

Zoning Committee Report (Bill Neale) on house under construction at 1713 Baurle, for which the city and the ZNA Zoning Committee agree that the roof structure is noncompliant with the land development code.
